

Kite Crafts

A simple, yet fun way to make a kite
- which although it won't fly outside,
if your little one runs around it will
"fly" behind them.

Materials

- sugar paper
- stickers
- ribbon
- string
- stapler
- glue
- thin garden canes

Instructions

1. draw a diamond on the sugar paper and cut this out - this will form the body of your kite, so you'll want it fairly big.
2. get your little one to decorate the kite using stickers, pens, etc. - it's great to see how creative they can be.
3. glue the garden canes in a cross shape on the back of the sugar paper.
4. cut some ribbon and staple this to the bottom of the kite.
5. tie some string to the garden canes - long enough so your little ones can run around with their kite.
